Eucharistic adoration of the reserved Blessed Sacrament is a devotional act. Which displays the Blessed Sacrament outside the tabernacle in a monstrance, for public veneration. It is a public celebration that enables the faithful to perceive more clearly the relationship between the reserved Sacrament and the "Sacrifice of the Mass [which] is truly the origin and the purpose of the worship that is shown to the Eucharist outside Mass". This is time set aside in a special way, which enables us to discover in our daily life an underlying spiritual rhythm. Within this rhythm we discover an increasing ability to offer more of our relationships and ourselves to the Father, and to accept the embrace that God is continuously extending to us in the person of his Son Jesus Christ.
