


At the weekend liturgies of July 27/28. 2024, Fr. Patrick Akinjo, a diocesan priest from ljebu-Ode diocese, Nigeria, will be here to speak about the missionary work currently going on in the Catholic Diocese of ljebu-Ode, Nigeria. Fr. Patrick is currently working a formator and lecturer in one of our seminaries in Nigeria. He has a vast knowledge of the rural area of the diocese, having played different roles in the affairs of the diocese for many years.

The Catholic Diocese of Ijebu-Ode is in Ogun State, the Western part of Nigeria, near Lagos, ljebu-Ode diocese is a mission diocese. Her population is predominantly Muslim; 50% Muslims, 25% Christians of the other demoniations, 15% of Catholics and 10% of Traditional African believers. The diocese has 45 parishes with over 150 churches, 7 houses of formation, 12 religious houses for male and female religious groups. The Catholic population does not have enough material and financial resources to sustain her many developing programs of evangelization; sustenance of 70 priests and 90 religious, training of 36 seminarians for the priesthood, and to sustain primary health care project for the villagers.

Our primary concern as a diocese is to spread the good news to all the nooks and crannies of the diocese through building schools, churches, training priests, religious and providing quality healthcare for the population. Your donation this year will help us to provide tuition fees for over 300 children in our Catholic schools, train 25 seminarians to become Priests, build 5 deep wells in rural communities without water and help us give over 500 children Malaria vaccines. The help and support of many generous people from all over the world, makes it possible to continue God's work in the missions.
