#### Our Lady of Fatima:

Our Lady of Fátima is the Virgin Mary in her six appearances before three peasant children near the village of Fátima, Portugal, in 1917. The children were Francisco and Jacinta Marto and their cousin Lucia dos Santos<sup>2</sup>. Our Lady came to warn us of the harm we would inflict upon ourselves as a result of our sins: wars, famines, plagues, persecution of the Church and the loss of many souls in Hell<sup>5</sup>. Since that revelation, millions of the faithful have made pilgrimages to the site where the woman, commonly called Our Lady of Fátima, appeared<sup>1</sup>
